Assessment of English Proficiency

- Overall performance level score of Well Developed (4) on ELPAC.

Comparison of Academic Performance in Basic Skills *LAT must document process

- CAASPP performance of Standards Met (SM) or Standards Exceeded (SE); if Standard Nearly Met (NM), average of 70% on CVUSD writing assessment (grades 4-6)
- Average 70% on CVUSD writing assessments for ELA Units
- C, B or A in ELA grades 7-12 for two consecutive semesters
- Read180 Core Replacement: Average basic proficiency in Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) and 70% on rSkills Tests – if no CAASPP scores available

Stay in ELD/SDAIE support until above criteria are met

YES

Parent Notification and Consultation

- Notify parents/guardians: *Parent Consultation & Initial Notification Letter*
- Follow up within five school days with parents who have not returned notification form.
- LAT must document process: *LAT Reclassification Readiness Form*

NO

Stay in ELD/SEI until above criteria are met

YES

Reclassification (MUST be within 30 days of formal parental notification)

- LAT determines if student is RFEP or not: *Language Reclassification & Analysis Results Form*
- Notify parents/guardians: *Parent Notification of Reclassification Results Letter*
- Update school records: Aeries, EL Portfolio (green folder)
- Notify district: EL Data Assessment Specialist
- Monitor the student's progress for four years at each semester
